The ability to purchase under the early adopter program will expire on or before June 30, 2020. Wildlife Computers reserves the right to cancel this program at any time.

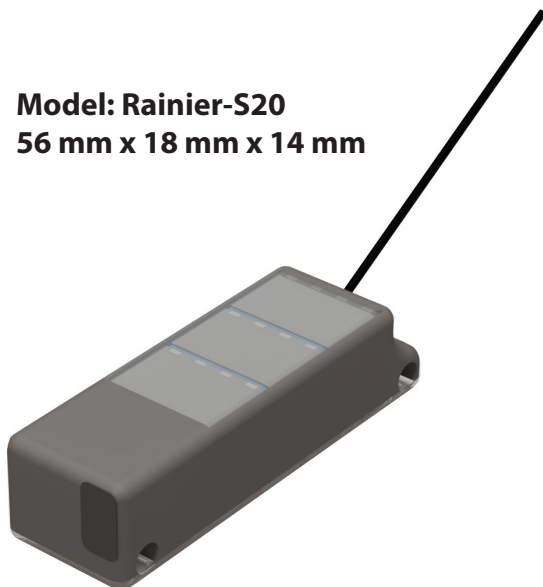
How Does the Program Work?

FAQ

Q: What do I get out of the program?

A: You get free tags to extend your research pool. You also receive a dedicated, hands-on support team, first-looks at new features, and a look at the upcoming roadmap for the product.

Q: How do I order my tags?

A: Once approved for the program, a technical sales consultant will contact you directly and help you place an order for your tags. Once the order is confirmed, and payment received, through the normal sales process, the TSC will create an addendum for the additional tags.

Q: Do I get to keep all the tags?

A: Yes, unless you cannot deploy the free tags within six months of receipt. Then you must send the tags back within 30 days or you will be billed for them.

Q: How will I know if I am accepted into the program?

A: Once we receive your application, you will hear from a technical sales consultant within two weeks via email with your acceptance or rejection.

Q: Does Wildlife Computers pay for the Argos fees?

A: No, the client is responsible for all Argos fees for the purchased and non-purchased tags.

Q: I don't want to participate because I don't want anyone knowing about my research before it is released.

A: As part of the agreement, Wildlife Computers agrees to not publicly disclose any information about the research until after publication or consent is given.
